HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, House Resolution 728 was adopted by the House of Representatives of the 91st General Assembly on April 14, 2000; and

WHEREAS, House Resolution 728 required the Board of Higher Education, the Illinois Community College Board, and the State Board of Education to conduct an analysis of the educational needs of the East St. Louis metropolitan area and to make a report to the Governor and the General Assembly during February 2001; and

WHEREAS, More time is needed to conduct this analysis, and a long-term study needs to be undertaken; therefore be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY, that the Board of Higher Education, the Illinois Community College Board, and the State Board of Education shall make a report to the General Assembly on or before May 15, 2001 on the analysis of the educational needs of the East St. Louis metropolitan area that was required to be conducted under House Resolution 728 of the 91st General Assembly; and be it further

RESOLVED, That in this report the Board of Higher Education, the Illinois Community College Board, and the State Board of Education shall advise the General Assembly on the need for a long-term study of the educational needs of the East St. Louis metropolitan area; and be it further

RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be delivered to the Chairperson of the Board of Higher Education, the Chairperson of the Illinois Community College Board, and the Chairperson of the State Board of Education.
