## HOUSE RESOLUTION 263

WHEREAS, A recent report revealed that 64 federal World
Wide Web sites used unauthorized information-collecting
cookies that allow those agencies to track the browsing and
buying habits of Internet users who visited those sites; and

WHEREAS, On October 11, 2000, a statement by the United States General Accounting Office indicated that some federal Web sites were lacking when measured against the Federal Trade Commission's four fair information principles: notice (data collectors must disclose their information practices before collecting personal information from consumers); choice (consumers must be given options with respect to whether and how personal information collected from them may be used for purposes beyond those for which the information was provided); access (consumers should be able to view and contest the accuracy and completeness of data collected about them); and security (data collectors must take reasonable steps to ensure that information collected from consumers is accurate and secure from unauthorized use); and

WHEREAS, Persons using Web sites maintained by officers and agencies of the State of Illinois are entitled to assurance that their privacy will be protected when they use those Web sites; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we direct the Auditor General to conduct an audit of each State officer and agency that maintains a World Wide Web site and determine whether the officer or agency uses technology that allows it to track the browsing or buying habits of Internet users who visit the site and, if so, whether the tracking is necessary and whether the officer or agency protects those users through adequate notice, choice, access,
