- 22 Illinois, and Northwestern Traffic Institute, Northwestern
- 23 University; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Chief Gallagher enlisted in the United States
- 25 Army in 1966, completed Officer Candidate School at Fort
- 26 Sill, Oklahoma in 1967, and was commissioned a Second
- 27 Lieutenant; he served as a Platoon Leader in Europe and,
- later, as a Platoon Leader and Company Commander in the
- 29 Republic of Vietnam in 1968 and 1969; he left active duty
- 30 with the rank of Captain and was awarded a Bronze Star and an
- 31 Army Commendation Medal; and

- 1 WHEREAS, While police chief of the Village of Winnetka,
- 2 Chief Gallagher was an active member and past President of
- 3 the North Suburban Chiefs Association, the Northern Illinois
- 4 Police Crime Laboratory, both the Illinois and the
- 5 International Association of Chiefs of Police, and the F.B.I.
- 6 National Academy Associates; he also served as Chairman of
- 7 the North Regional Major Crimes Task Force; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Chief Gallagher and his wife live in Winnetka;
- 9 they have three adult daughters and three grandsons;
