- WHEREAS, President Reagan's commitment to our armed

- 28 prepared America's Armed Forces to win the Gulf War; and
- 29 WHEREAS, President Reagan's "vision of peace through
- 30 strength" led to the end of the Cold War and the ultimate
- 31 demise of the Soviet Union, guaranteeing basic human rights

- 3 celebrate his 91st birthday, thus becoming the oldest living
- 4 former President; therefore, be it
