- 18 WHEREAS, Appeals mechanisms delay treatment and cause
- 19 patients and their families anxiety about whether they are
- 20 receiving the medical care the doctor thinks is best or only
- 21 the medical care that their health plan will allow;

- 24 NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
- 25 we support legislation to prohibit prior authorization
- 26 requirements, formularies, financial incentives, and other
- 27 impediments that attempt to control the doctor's
- 28 recommendation and patient's choice of a particular drug or
- 29 course of treatment to meet the patient's needs; and be it

- 1 based on the same premise of allowing doctors to make the
- 2 appropriate recommendation for prescription drugs based on
- 3 patient's needs.
