The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by 4 adding Section 12-21.7 as follows: 5 б (720 ILCS 5/12-21.7 new) Sec. 12-21.7. Leaving a child unattended in a vehicle. 7 (a) A person commits the offense of leaving a child 8 unattended in a vehicle when he or she knowingly leaves a 9 child under 11 years of age unattended in a motor vehicle. 10 (b) For purposes of this Section: 11 (1) "Injury" means physical harm to the body of a 12 13 <u>person;</u> (2) "Motor vehicle" means every device, in, upon, 14 15 or by which not more than 10 persons may be transported 16 or drawn upon a highway, except devices moved by human power, devices used exclusively upon stationary rails or 17 tracks and snowmobiles as defined in the Snowmobile 18 19 Registration and Safety Act. (3) "Unattended" means not accompanied by a person 20 21 14 years of age or older. (c) Sentence. A violation of this Section is a Class C 22 misdemeanor. A violation of this Section that is the 23 proximate cause of injury to the child or to any other person 24 is a Class A misdemeanor. A violation of this Section that 25 is the proximate cause of death of the child or any other 26 27 person is a Class 4 felony.
