16	of age or younger unattended in a motor vehicle. For
17	purposes of this subsection:
18	(1) There is a rebuttable presumption that a person
19	committed the offense if he or she left a child 6 years
20	of age or younger unattended in a motor vehicle for more
21	than 10 minutes.
22	(2) "Unattended" means either: (i) not accompanied

- by a person 14 years of age or older; or (ii) if
- 2 <u>accompanied by a person 14 years of age or older, out of</u>
- 3 <u>sight of that person.</u>
- 4 (b) A violation of this Section is a Class A
- 5 misdemeanor. A second or subsequent violation of this
- 6 Section is a Class 3 felony. A violation of this Section
- 7 that is a proximate cause of the death of the child is a
- 8 Class 3 felony for which a person, if sentenced to a term of
- 9 imprisonment, shall be sentenced to a term of not less than 2
- 10 years and not more than 10 years.
