- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 5.545 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 105/5.545 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 5.545. The Marine Corps Scholarship Fund.</u>
- 8 Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
- 9 adding Section 3-648 as follows:
- 10 (625 ILCS 5/3-648 new)
- 11 <u>Sec. 3-648. U.S. Marine Corps license plates.</u>
- 12 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the
- 13 <u>Secretary</u>, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
- 14 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of
- 15 <u>State, may issue special registration plates designated as</u>
- 16 <u>U.S. Marine Corps license plates to residents of Illinois who</u>
- 17 <u>meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of</u>
- 18 State. The special plate issued under this Section shall be
- 19 <u>affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division,</u>
- 20 <u>motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than</u>
- 21 8,000 pounds, and recreational vehicles as defined by Section
