- 4 Section 5. The Department of Public Health Powers and
- 5 Duties Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is
- 6 amended by adding Section 2310-605 as follows:
- 7 (20 ILCS 2310/2310-605 new)
- 8 <u>Sec. 2310-605. Dementia Patient Care Advisory Committee.</u>
- 9 The Director of Public Health shall appoint a Dementia
- 10 Patient Care Advisory Committee to study appropriate care and
- 11 <u>staffing for dementia patients residing in long-term care</u>
- 12 <u>facilities</u>. The Advisory Committee shall make
- 13 recommendations regarding appropriate standards of care and
- 14 staffing to the Director by April 15, 2002. The Advisory
- 15 <u>Committee shall be composed of the following members with</u>
- 16 <u>knowledge of long-term care, dementia, and senior advocacy:</u>
- 17 <u>the Director of Aging, or his or her designee; 3</u>
- 18 <u>representatives of long-term care; a representative of the</u>
