- 1 AN ACT relating to schools.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 18-4.4 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/18-4.4) (from Ch. 122, par. 18-4.4)
- 7 Sec. 18-4.4. Tax Equivalent Grants. When any State
- 8 institution is located in a school district in which the
- 9 State owns 45% or more of the total land area of the district
- 10 <u>or when a United States military installation or base is</u>
- 11 <u>located in a school district with a population of less than</u>
- 12 <u>500,000</u>, the State Superintendent of Education shall annually
- 13 direct the State Comptroller to pay the amount of the
- 14 tax-equivalent grants provided in this Section, and the State
- 15 Comptroller shall draw his warrant upon the State Treasurer
- 16 for the payment of the grants. For fiscal year 1995 and each
- 17 fiscal year thereafter, the grant shall equal 0.5% of the
- 18 equalized assessed valuation of the land owned by the State
- 19 <u>or United States</u> (computing that equalized assessed valuation
- 20 by multiplying the average value per taxable acre of the
- 21 school district by the total number of acres of land owned by
- 22 the State <u>or the United States</u>). Annually on or before
- 23 September 15, 1994 and July 1, thereafter, the district
- 24 superintendent shall certify to the State Board of Education
- 25 the following matters:
- 1. The name of the State institution or United
- 27 <u>States military installation or base</u>.
- 28 2. The total land area of the district in acres.
- 29 3. The total ownership of the land of the State <u>or</u>
- 30 <u>United States</u> in acres.
- 31 4. The total equalized assessed value of all the

- land in the district.
- 2 5. The rate of school tax payable in the year.
- 3 6. The computed amount of the tax-equivalent grant
- 4 claimed.
- 5 Failure of any district superintendent to certify the
- 6 claim for the tax-equivalent grant on or before September 15,
- 7 1994 or July 1 of a subsequent year shall constitute a
- 8 forfeiture by the district of its right to such grant for the
- 9 school year.
