- 7 Sec. 18-4.4. Tax Equivalent Grants. When any State
- 8 institution is located in a school district in which the

- 10 <u>or when a United States military installation or base is</u>
- 11 <u>located in a school district with a population of less than</u>
- 12 500,000 and there are students residing on the military
