- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by
- 5 changing Sections 5-178 and 5-179 as follows:
- 6 (40 ILCS 5/5-178) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 5-178)
- 7 Sec. 5-178. Board created. A board of 8 members shall
- 8 constitute a board of trustees authorized to administer the
- 9 provisions of this Article. The board shall be known as the
- 10 Retirement Board of the Policemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund
- 11 of the city.

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- 12 The board shall consist of 4 persons appointed by the

- 24 the election is held have a right to vote <u>for all active</u>
