- 12 <u>the family of that person shall be inadmissible as evidence</u>
- of an admission of liability in a civil action. A statement
- of fault, however, that is part of, or in addition to, any of
- the above shall not be inadmissible pursuant to this Section.
- 16 (b) For purposes of this Section:
- 17 <u>(1) "Accident" means an occurrence resulting in</u>
- 18 <u>injury or death to one or more persons that is not the result</u>
- of willful action by a party.
- 20 (2) "Benevolent gestures" means actions that convey
- 21 <u>a sense of compassion or commiseration emanating from</u>
