- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 16-106.5 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/16-106.5 new)
- 7 Sec. 16-106.5. Pilot project; notice of violation to
- 8 owner.
- 9 <u>(a) A pilot project is created that shall be in</u>
- 10 operation from January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2003 in
- 11 the counties of DuPage, Kendall, and Sangamon. Under the
- 12 pilot project, when a traffic citation is issued for a
- violation of this Code to a person who is under the age of 18
- 14 years, who is a resident of the county in which the traffic
- 15 <u>citation was issued, and who is not the registered owner of</u>
- 16 <u>the vehicle named in the traffic citation, the circuit clerk</u>
- of the county in which the traffic citation was issued shall,
- 18 <u>within 10 days after the traffic citation is filed with the</u>
- 19 <u>circuit clerk, send notice of the issuance of the traffic</u>
- 20 <u>citation to the registered owner of the vehicle. The notice</u>
- 21 <u>must include:</u>
