AN ACT in relation to alcoholic liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Liquor Control Act of 1934 is amended by 5 adding Section 6-32 as follows:

б (235 ILCS 5/6-32 new) 7 Sec. 6-32. Drive-through sales prohibited. (a) No licensee under this Act may sell alcoholic liquor 8 at a drive-up location. For the purpose of this Section, the 9 term "licensee" includes any agent or employee of a person 10 who is licensed under this Act. For the purpose of this 11 Section, the term "drive-up location" means any location 12 13 where a person may purchase alcoholic liquor from within his 14 or her vehicle.

15 (b) A person who violates this Section is guilty of a
16 <u>Class B misdemeanor.</u>

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect uponbecoming law.
