AN ACT concerning criminal identification information.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Criminal Identification Act is amended by 5 changing Section 3.1 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 2630/3.1) (from Ch. 38, par. 206-3.1)

7 Sec. 3.1. <u>Criminal History Record Information</u>.

8 The Department may furnish, pursuant to positive (a) identification, records of convictions <u>simultaneously</u> to the 9 Department of Professional Regulation and agencies licensed 10 pursuant to the Private Detective, Private Alarm, Private 11 Security, and Locksmith Act of 1993 for the purpose of 12 13 meeting registration or licensure requirements under The Private Detective, Private Alarm, and Private Security Act of 14 15 1983.

(b) The Department may furnish, pursuant to positive
identification, records of convictions to <u>the Illinois Liquor</u>
<u>Control Commission and to</u> policing bodies of this State for
the purpose of assisting local liquor control commissioners
in carrying out their duty to refuse to issue licenses to
persons specified in paragraphs (4), (5) and (6) of Section
6-2 of The Liquor Control Act of 1934.

(c) The Department shall charge an application fee, 23 based on actual costs, for the dissemination of records 24 received for 25 pursuant to this Section. Fees the dissemination of records pursuant to this Section shall be 26 27 deposited in the State Police Services Fund. The Department is empowered to establish this fee and to prescribe the form 28 29 and manner for requesting and furnishing conviction 30 information pursuant to this Section.

31 (d) Any dissemination of any information obtained
