AN ACT in relation to education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing
5 Section 21-11.3 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/21-11.3) (from Ch. 122, par. 21-11.3)

Sec. 21-11.3. Resident teacher certificate. A resident 7 8 teacher certificate shall be valid for 2 years for employment as a resident teacher in a public school. It shall be issued 9 only to persons who have graduated from a regionally 10 accredited institution of higher education with a bachelor's 11 degree, who are enrolled in a program of preparation approved 12 13 by the State Superintendent of Education in consultation with the State Teacher Certification Board, and who have passed 14 15 the appropriate tests as required in Section 21-1a of this 16 <u>Code</u> and as determined by the State Board of Education. Α resident teacher certificate may be issued for teaching 17 18 children through grade 3 or for grades K-9, 6-12, or K-12 in a special subject area and may not be renewed. A resident 19 20 teacher may teach only in conjunction with and under the direction of a certified teacher and shall not teach in place 21 22 of a certified teacher.
