- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by

- 7 <u>Sec. 7-103. Dangerous intersection study.</u>
- 8 (a) The Department shall conduct an annual study of all
- 9 <u>intersections throughout this State to determine the 100 most</u>
- 10 <u>dangerous intersections</u>. The criteria the <u>Department shall</u>
- 11 <u>use to determine the most dangerous intersections includes,</u>
- but is not limited to, the following:
- 13 (1) the number of motor vehicle accidents at each
- <u>intersection;</u>
- 15 (2) the number of pedestrians injured at each
- 16 <u>intersection;</u>
- 17 (3) the number of deaths and the number of personal
- 18 <u>injuries that occur as a result of an accident at each</u>
- 19 <u>intersection; and</u>
- 20 (4) the number of motor vehicles and the number of
- 21 <u>pedestrians that use each intersection on a daily</u>
- 22 <u>average</u>.
- 23 (b) The Department shall, upon the conclusion of its
- 24 <u>annual study to determine the 100 most dangerous</u>
- 25 <u>intersections</u> in the State, report its findings of the 100
- 26 <u>most dangerous intersections in the State to the Speaker of</u>
- 27 <u>the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate</u>
- 28 <u>and explain what measures the Department has taken to</u>
