- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Children and Family Services Act is
- 5 amended by adding Section 7.4 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 505/7.4 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 7.4. Placement of siblings.</u>
- 8 (a) Before placing a child for adoption, the Department
- 9 shall examine its files and other available resources and
- 10 <u>attempt to determine whether any biological sibling of the</u>
- 11 <u>child has been adopted. If the Department determines that a</u>
- 12 <u>biological sibling of the child has been adopted, the</u>
- 13 Department shall make a good faith effort to locate the
- 14 adoptive parents of the sibling and inform them of the
- 15 <u>availability of the child for adoption.</u>
- 16 (b) If the adoptive parents of a biological sibling of a
- 17 <u>child available for adoption apply to adopt that child, the</u>
- 18 <u>Department shall give them preference and first consideration</u>
- 19 over all other applicants for adoption of the child. The
- 20 <u>Department's final decision, however, shall be based upon the</u>
- 21 <u>welfare and best interest of the child. In arriving at its</u>
- 22 <u>decision</u>, the Department shall consider all relevant factors,
- 23 <u>including but not limited to:</u>
- 24 (1) the wishes of the child;
- 25 (2) the interaction and interrelationship of the
- 26 <u>child with the applicant to adopt the child;</u>

- of relationship with parent figures;
