- 4 Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business
- 5 Practices Act is amended by adding Section 2MM as follows:

- 7 <u>Sec. 2MM. Receipts; credit card account number.</u>
- 8 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this Section, a
- 9 person who accepts credit cards for the transaction of
- 10 <u>business</u> may not print more than the last 5 digits of the
- 11 <u>credit card account number or the expiration date upon any</u>
- 12 <u>receipt provided to the cardholder. A person who violates</u>
- this Section commits an unlawful practice within the meaning
- of this Act.
- 15 (b) This Section applies only to receipts that are
- 16 <u>electronically printed and does not apply to transactions in</u>
- 17 <u>which the sole means of recording the person's credit card</u>
- 18 <u>number is by handwriting or by an imprint or copy of the</u>
- 19 <u>credit card.</u>
- 20 (c) This Section becomes operative on January 1, 2007,
