- 4 Section 5. The Barber, Cosmetology, Esthetics, and Nail

- 10 (1) A person is qualified to receive a license as a
- 11 cosmetologist who has filed an application on forms provided
- by the Department, pays the required fees, and:
- a. Is at least 16 years of age; and
- 14 b. Has graduated from an eighth grade elementary
- school, or its equivalent; and

consecutive years.

- 16 c. Has graduated from a school of cosmetology
- 17 approved by the Department, having completed a program
- 18 total of 1500 hours in the study of cosmetology extending
- over a period of not less than 8 months nor more than 7

A school of cosmetology may, at its

- discretion, consistent with the rules of the Department,
- accept up to 500 hours of barber school training at a
- 23 recognized barber school toward the 1500 hour program
- requirement of cosmetology. Time spent in such study
- 25 under the laws of another state or territory of the
- 26 United States or of a foreign country or province shall

  sit for the examination. The Department shall promulgate
  rules establishing the standards by which such
  determination shall be made; and
- 7 e. Has met any other requirements of this Act.
- 8 (2) If the applicant applies for a license as a 9 cosmetologist on September 1, 2000 or September 2, 2000, the 10 Department may accept a verified 10 years of cosmetology experience, which may include esthetics or nail technology experience, before July 1, 2000 in lieu of the requirements 13 in items c and d of subsection (1) of this Section.
