AN ACT concerning capital sentencing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Criminal Justice Information Act
is amended by adding Section 9.3 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 3930/9.3 new)

Sec. 9.3. Study of proportionality in capital sentencing. 7 8 (a) The Authority shall employ appropriately qualified experts to conduct a study of all cases in the State in which 9 a defendant was charged with the offense of first degree 10 murder committed on or after June 21, 1977 in violation of 11 Section 9-1 of the Criminal Code of 1961 to determine whether 12 13 the race, ethnicity, or gender of either the defendant or the victim, the location of the offense, or some combination of 14 these factors has tended to influence whether the defendant 15 16 was sentenced to death. The Authority shall provide all relevant data in its possession to assist the experts in the 17 preparation of the study. This study shall employ appropriate 18 19 statistical techniques to take into account the nature of the offense and all other aggravating and mitigating 20 circumstances. The study shall be completed within 2 years 21 22 after the effective date of this Section.

23 (b) There is a moratorium on the execution of all
24 capital sentences in this State until the completion of the
25 study called for by subsection (a) of this Section.
