AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1782 1 2 AMENDMENT NO. ____. Amend Senate Bill 1782 by replacing 3 everything after the enacting clause with the following: 4 "Section 5. The Department of Human Services Act is 5 amended by adding Section 10-7 as follows: 6 (20 ILCS 1305/10-7 new) Sec. 10-7. Postpartum depression. The Department, in 7 cooperation with the Department of Professional Regulation, 8 9 must work with licensed health care facilities and licensed health care professionals to develop policies that meet all 10 of the following objectives that address the issue of 11 postpartum depression: 12 (1) For physicians and other licensed health care 13 14 professionals who provide prenatal care to women, to provide education to women and their families about 15 postpartum depression in order to lower the likelihood 16 17 that new mothers will continue to suffer from the illness in silence. 18 (2) For physicians and other health care personnel 19 who provide postnatal care to women, to screen new 20 21 mothers for postpartum depression symptoms prior to 22 discharge from hospital and at the first few postnatal 1 <u>checkups.</u>

2	(3) For physicians and other licensed health care
3	professionals who provide prenatal and postnatal care to
4	women, to include fathers and other family members, as
5	appropriate, in both the education and treatment
6	processes to help them better understand the nature and
7	causes of postpartum depression so that they can overcome
8	the spillover effects of the illness and improve their
9	ability to be supportive of the new mother.".
