- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Township Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 35-55 as follows:
- 6 (60 ILCS 1/35-55)
- 7 Sec. 35-55. Senior citizens services; authorization of
- 8 tax levy.

- 9 (a) The electors may authorize the township board to
- levy a tax (at a rate of not more than 0.15% of the value, as
- 11 equalized and assessed by the Department of Revenue, of all
- 12 taxable property in the township) for the sole and exclusive
- 13 purpose of providing services to senior citizens under
- 14 Article 220 including, but not limited to, the construction,
- 15 <u>maintenance</u>, repair, and operation of a senior citizens
- 16 <u>center</u> 270. If the board desires to levy the tax, it shall
- order a referendum on the proposition to be held at an
- 18 election in accordance with the general election law. The
- 19 board shall certify the proposition to the proper election
- 20 officials, who shall submit the proposition to the voters at

- 2 township, it shall order a referendum on that proposition to
