- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by

- 7 Sec. 17-11.2. Failure to restore a deployed or damaged

- 9 (a) It is a violation of this Section for a body shop,

- 11 <u>other person to:</u>
- 12 <u>(1) knowingly fail to fully restore and repair to</u>
- 13 <u>all applicable federal safety regulations an airbag</u>
- 14 passive restraint system that is deployed or damaged in a
- motor vehicle accident or in any other manner;
- 16 (2) knowingly cause another person not to fully
- 17 <u>restore and repair an airbag passive restraint system</u>
- that is deployed or damaged in a motor vehicle accident
- or in any other manner; or
- 20 (3) knowingly install an airbag passive restraint
- 21 <u>system which has been previously been installed in</u>
- 22 <u>another motor vehicle without disclosing in writing to</u>
- 23 <u>the owner or lessee of the vehicle receiving the airbag</u>

- 27 (b) A body shop, salvage rebuilder, vehicle service

- 5 Section 10. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business

- 8 Sec. 2Z. Violations of other Acts. Any person who
- 9 knowingly violates the Automotive Repair Act, the Home Repair

- 11 Fitness Services Act, the Hearing Instrument Consumer
- 12 Protection Act, the Illinois Union Label Act, the Job
- 13 Referral and Job Listing Services Consumer Protection Act,
- 14 the Travel Promotion Consumer Protection Act, the Credit
- 15 Services Organizations Act, the Automatic Telephone Dialers
- 16 Act, the Pay-Per-Call Services Consumer Protection Act, the
- 17 Telephone Solicitations Act, the Illinois Funeral or Burial
- 18 Funds Act, the Cemetery Care Act, the Safe and Hygienic Bed
- 19 Act, the Pre-Need Cemetery Sales Act, subsection (a) or (b)
