AN ACT concerning counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing
Section 5-1103 as follows:

6 (55 ILCS 5/5-1103) (from Ch. 34, par. 5-1103)

Sec. 5-1103. Court services fee. A county board may 7 8 enact by ordinance or resolution a court services fee dedicated to defraying court security expenses incurred by 9 the sheriff in providing court services or for any other 10 court services deemed necessary by the sheriff to provide for 11 court security, including without limitation court services 12 provided pursuant to Section 3-6023, as now or hereafter 13 amended. Such fee shall be paid in civil cases by each party 14 15 at the time of filing the first pleading, paper or other 16 appearance; provided that no additional fee shall be required if more than one party is represented in a single pleading, 17 18 paper or other appearance. In criminal, local ordinance, county ordinance, traffic and conservation cases, such fee 19 20 shall be assessed against the defendant upon a plea of guilty, stipulation of facts or findings of guilty, resulting 21 22 in a judgment of conviction, or order of supervision, or sentence of probation without entry of judgment pursuant to 23 Section 10 of the Cannabis Control Act, Section 410 of the 24 Illinois Controlled Substances Act, Section 12-4.3 of the 25 Criminal Code of 1961, Section 10-102 of the Illinois 26 27 Alcoholism and Other Drug Dependency Act, Section 40-10 of the Alcoholism and Other Drug Abuse and Dependency Act, or 28 29 Section 10 of the Steroid Control Act. In setting such fee, the county board may impose, with the concurrence of the 30 Chief Judge of the judicial circuit in which the county is 31

1 located by administrative order entered by the Chief Judge, 2 differential rates for the various types or categories of 3 criminal and civil cases, but the maximum rate shall not 4 exceed <u>\$25</u> \$15. No fee shall be imposed or collected, however, in traffic, conservation, and ordinance cases in 5 б which fines are paid without a court appearance. The fees 7 shall be collected in the manner in which all other court fees or costs are collected and shall be deposited into the 8 9 county general fund for payment solely of costs incurred by 10 the sheriff in providing court security or for any other court services deemed necessary by the sheriff to provide for 11 court security. 12
