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1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Health care service contracts between insurers,

- 3 health plans, businesses, unions, health care professionals
- 4 and health care providers have become the primary method of
- 5 arranging for the delivery of health care to the people of
- 6 Illinois; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The Illinois General Assembly is currently
- 8 debating the Fairness in Health Care Services Contracting Act
- which attempts to ensure that both parties to a contract for 9
- 10 the provision of health care services understand the terms
- and conditions for the provision of those services; and 11
- WHEREAS, The professional services contracts entered into 12
- 13 between health care plans and health care professionals and
- 14 health care providers have a significant impact on the
- delivery of health care services to the people of Illinois; 15
- 16 and

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- 17 WHEREAS, The relationship between the health care plan
- contract with the professionals and providers is akin to the 18
- 19 insurance policy for coverage with the insureds or enrollees;
- 20 therefore, be it
- 21 RESOLVED, BY SENATE OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY
- OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 22
- CONCURRING HEREIN, that there is created the 23
- Legislative Task Force on Fairness in Health Care Services 24
- Contracting consisting of six voting members; two of whom 25
- shall be members of the Senate appointed by the President of
- 27 the Senate, one of whom shall serve as Co-chairperson, one of

- Minority Leader of the Senate, two of whom shall be members 29

- 3 designee, the Director of Public Health or his or her
- 4 designee, the Director of Public Aid or his or her designee,
- 5 and the Director of Central Management Services or his or her
- 6 designee shall serve as ex officio non-voting members of the
- 7 Task Force; and be it further
- 8 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall include the following
- 9 non-voting members; including one representative of the
- 10 following organizations; Illinois Hospital and HealthSystems
- 11 Association, Illinois State Dental Society, Illinois Nurses
- 12 Association, Illinois Pharmacists Association, Illinois State
- 13 Medical Society, Illinois Podiatric Medical Society, Illinois
- 14 Optometric Association, Illinois Association of Clinical
- 15 Psychologists, Illinois Association of Freestanding Surgery
- 16 Centers, Illinois Association of Health Plans, Managed Health
- 17 Providers Association, Illinois Life Insurance Council, Blue
- 18 Cross/Blue Shield of Illinois, Illinois Chamber of Commerce,
- 19 Illinois Manufacturers Association, Illinois Retail Merchants
- 20 Association, AFL/CIO, and the City of Chicago; and be it
- 21 further
- 22 RESOLVED, That the meetings of the Task Force shall be
- 23 held at the call of the Co-chairpersons and that the
- 24 non-voting members of the Task Force shall serve without
- 25 compensation; and be it further
- 26 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall study the health plan
- 27 professional and provider services contracting process; and
- 28 be it further
- 29 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall report its
- 30 recommendations to the General Assembly and Governor on or
- 31 before January 15, 2002.
