3 WHEREAS, The State Board of Education has filed its 4 Report on Waiver of School Code Mandates, dated September 28, 5 2001, with the Senate, the House of Representatives, and the 6 Secretary of State of Illinois as required by Section 2-3.25g 7 of the School Code; and

8 WHEREAS, We are disapproving school district requests for 9 waivers relating to substitute certificates because Public 10 Act 92-184 just became law on July 27, 2001, allowing certain 11 substitute teachers to teach for more than 90 days, and this 12 change in current law is for only 3 years while the waiver 13 request is for 5 years; therefore, be it
