1 SENATE RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, Deaf and hard of hearing children are entitled
- 3 to the same rights of self-actualization as hearing children;
- 4 and
- 5 WHEREAS, There is limited access to many community
- 6 resources; deaf and hard of hearing children have a right to
- 7 fully accessible educational opportunities; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Severe communication deficits may result from
- 9 deafness, and deaf and hard of hearing children have a right
- 10 to an education in which their unique communication needs are
- 11 respected and utilized; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Deaf and hard of hearing children need to
- 13 socialize and interact with peers with whom they can
- 14 communicate; and
- WHEREAS, Deaf and hard of hearing children may experience
- 16 severe academic delay and are entitled to professionals and
- 17 teachers who are properly trained and certified and able to
- 18 communicate directly with them; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Deafness impacts all areas of development;
- 20 school districts should consider the social, emotional,
- 21 cultural, communication, academic, and style of learning
- 22 needs of deaf and hard of hearing children for educational
- 23 placement; therefore, be it
- 24 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL
- 25 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge the State
- 26 Board of Education to work in conjunction with the schools
- 27 toward a better system of communication with the families of
- deaf and hard of hearing children in order to ensure that the
- 29 families understand the available service options and
- 30 services to which their children are entitled; and be it
- 31 further
