RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL 9 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that the members of the 10 11 Illinois State Senate reaffirm that the Illinois Aeronautics Act and other relevant State laws are vital to protecting the 12 interests of the citizens of the State of Illinois with 13 respect to airport development projects and their impact on 14 the State's overall air and ground transportation systems, 15 regional mass transit systems, public health and safety, the 16 17 environment, land use, public finances, and other relevant 18 areas; and be it further

19 RESOLVED, that the members of the Illinois State Senate 20 oppose any federal effort to preempt the State of Illinois' 21 laws concerning airport development projects.
