23 WHEREAS, As important as work was to Mr. Tomy, he also 24 delighted in spending as much time as possible with loved 25 ones; his family outings included dozens of boating 26 excursions; Mr. Tomy loved his children and he would do 27 anything for them; and

28 WHEREAS, Mr. Tomy will be deeply missed by all those who 29 knew him and loved him, especially his wife, Patricia; his 30 daughters, Christine Randa and Tracy Johnson; his father, 31 Paul; his brother, Robert; and his granddaughter; therefore, 1 be it
