WHEREAS. Dr. Putrina Dunlap-Deas was born on April 28, 1965 in Chicago, Illinois; she was the daughter of Mrs. Rudell Betts Dunlap Jackson and the late Eddie Lee Dunlap; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Dunlap-Deas' educational training included Loyola University of Chicago, where she received a Bachelors of Science degree with honors in Pre-Med, the University of Illinois College of Medicine, where she received her medical degree and graduated with honors in Genetics, and the Cleveland Clinic Foundation, where she completed her residency (Orthopaedic Surgery), the James A. Dickson Fellowship in Adult Reconstructive Orthopaedic Surgery, and an Internship in General Surgery; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Dunlap-Deas' professional employment included the University of South Carolina School of Medicine; there she served as an Assistant Professor in the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery; she also worked with the Ohio Permanente Medical Group in the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery (Cleveland, OH); At the time of her death, she was in private practice in the area of Orthopaedic Surgery with Dr. Barry Oliver; and
