

AN ACT concerning local government.

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
represented in the General Assembly:**

Section 5. The Township Code is amended by changing Section 5-55 as follows:

(60 ILCS 1/5-55)

Sec. 5-55. Duplicate township names. If the Secretary of State, on comparing the abstracts of the reports from the several counties, finds that any 2 or more townships within a single county are named alike, he or she shall so inform the clerk of the county ~~which last adopted the name~~. The county board of that county shall, at its next meeting, adopt for one of the townships ~~a the township some~~ different name. When the name is adopted, the county clerk shall inform the Secretary of State as provided in Section 5-50.
