AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Local Volunteer Board Member Removal Act.

Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act:

"Board" means a volunteer board or commission of a governing or administrative body of a unit of local government.

"Member" means an appointed member of a board serving without compensation, other than reimbursement for actual expenses. "Member" does not include an individual who is appointed to fill a vacancy on an elected board of a unit of local government.

Section 10. Removal of volunteer board members.

- (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the person or entity that appointed a member of a board may remove that member for misconduct, official misconduct, or neglect of office.
- (b) Removal under this Section is in addition to any other method of removal provided by law.
