**PRESENTATION OF RESOLUTION**

**SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1**

**RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, AT THE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION THEREOF, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING HEREIN**, that when the two Houses adjourn on Friday, July 02, 2004, the Senate stands adjourned until Tuesday, July 06, 2004 at 2:30 o'clock p.m.; and the House of Representatives stands adjourned until Monday, July 05, 2004, in perfunctory session.
