SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 175

WHEREAS, Grand juries have always had the responsibility of investigating, indicting, and prosecuting persons who violate the criminal laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, In light of recent events around the country, members of the public have lost confidence in the criminal justice system and the grand jury process; and

WHEREAS, The General Assembly finds that the grand jury process utilized in this State should be reviewed to ensure the impartiality and effectiveness of the process; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that the Grand Jury Review Task Force is created to review the current grand jury process and suggest reforms to the General Assembly; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall consist of the following members:

- (1) One member appointed by the President of the Senate, who shall serve as co-chairperson;
- (2) One member appointed by the Senate Minority Leader, who shall serve as co-chairperson;
- (3) The Director of the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority, or his or her designee;
- (4) The Director of the Illinois Office of the State's Attorney Appellate Prosecutor, or his or her designee;
- (5) The State Appellate Defender, or his or her designee;
- (6) The Executive Director of the Illinois State Bar Association, or his or her designee;
- (7) The President of the Chicago Bar Association, or his or her designee;
- (8) The President of the American Civil Liberties Union of Illinois, or his or her designee;
- (9) One law professor, appointed by the President of the Senate;
- (10) One retired judge, appointed by the President of the Senate;
- (11) One member representing the Chicago Innocence Project, appointed by the President of the Senate;
- (12) Two members representing advocacy groups involved in criminal justice, one of which is to be appointed by the President of the Senate and one to be appointed by the Senate Minority Leader;
- (13) Two members of the public, one of which is to be appointed by the President of the Senate and one to be appointed by the Senate Minority Leader; and
- (14) The President of the Illinois Press Association, or his or her designee; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall meet regularly and hold public hearings at the call of the co-chairpersons to receive testimony regarding the grand jury process and any suggested reforms; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority shall provide administrative support and technical assistance, as well as meeting space, to the Task Force; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Grand Jury Review Task Force shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly and the Governor on or before December 31, 2015; the report shall, at a minimum, include:

- (1) A summary of the current grand jury process;
- (2) Any and all deficiencies discovered within the current grand jury process;
- (3) Recommendations to improve the grand jury process;
- (4) A recommendation advising whether grand jury proceedings shall remain closed to the public;
- (5) A recommendation advising whether certain portions of grand jury proceedings should be subject to the Freedom of Information Act; and
- (6) A recommendation regarding whether an expanded use of preliminary hearings would advance the same goals as the grand jury process; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall also work with the Legislative Reference Bureau to draft any legislation needed to implement its recommendations.

WHEREAS, The story of the Ghere brothers and their commitment to their country is remarkable and unprecedented; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING HEREIN, that we designate Route 133 as it passes through Douglas County as the "Ghere Brothers Memorial Highway"; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Illinois Department of Transportation is requested to erect at suitable locations, consistent with State and federal regulations, appropriate plaques or signs giving notice of the name "Ghere Brothers Memorial Highway"; and be it further

RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be delivered to the Secretary of the Illinois Department of Transportation and the family of the Ghere brothers.

- (12) a representative of a statewide association representing school boards, appointed by the Governor;
- (13) a representative of a park district, appointed by the Governor; and
- (14) a representative of township government, appointed by the Governor; and be it

RESOLVED, That the members of the Task Force shall select a chairperson from among themselves; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall meet at the call of the chair or any 8 members; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall conduct a study on personal property replacement taxes; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall identify the types of entities that pay personal property replacement taxes in this State and shall study the distribution of personal property replacement tax revenue and the ways in which the population and businesses have shifted since personal property replacement taxes were first introduced; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the members of the Task Force shall serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for their reasonable and necessary expenses from funds appropriated for that purpose; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Department of Revenue shall provide administrative support to the Task Force; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall submit its findings to the General Assembly no later than August 1, 2015; and be it further

RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be presented to the Governor and the Director of Revenue.

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 14

WHEREAS, In response to concerns regarding premium costs for Illinois employers responsible for providing Workers' Compensation Insurance coverage for their employees, the State of Illinois enacted Public Act 97-0018 which created a substantial reduction in benefits for injured workers, with the intention of providing employers relief from the high costs of workers' compensation premiums; and

WHEREAS, As a result of this Act, the National Council on Compensation Insurance has subsequently recommended premium rate reductions totaling nearly 20% for Illinois employers; and

WHEREAS, If fully implemented by insurers, such a rate reduction would provide Illinois' employers with nearly \$1 billion in premium savings; and

WHEREAS, Employers have experienced premium reductions of \$315 million, which represents only a fraction of the \$1 billion that would have been saved via full implementation of the recommended rate reductions; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING HEREIN, that there is created the Workers' Compensation Premium Rates Task Force consisting of 12 members appointed as follows: 2 legislative members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; 2 legislative members appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives; 2 legislative members appointed by the President of the Senate; 2 legislative members appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate; one member representing a statewide association representing retailers; one member of a statewide association representing manufacturers; one member of a statewide association representing labor

interests; and one member of a statewide association representing injured workers; 2 chairpersons, representing different political parties, shall be selected by the members of the Task Force; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall study the National Council on Compensation Insurance's recommendations for workers' compensation premium rates and the extent to which Illinois employers' actual premiums reflect these recommended rates; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall report its findings and recommendations to the Illinois House of Representatives and the Illinois Senate no later than December 31, 2015.

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT**

SC0012

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING HEREIN, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the State for adoption or rejection at the general election next occurring at least 6 months after the adoption of this resolution a proposition to amend Article V of the Illinois Constitution by changing Section 2 as follows:

ARTICLE V
THE EXECUTIVE

SECTION 2. TERMS

(a) These elected officers of the Executive Branch shall hold office for four years beginning on the second Monday of January after their election and, except in the case of the Lieutenant Governor, until their successors are qualified. They shall be elected at the general election in 1978 and every four years thereafter.

(b) No person shall be elected to the same Executive Branch office more than twice, and no person who has held the office of an Executive Branch officer as Acting Governor or as an appointee for more than two years of a term to which some other person was elected to that office shall be elected to that Executive Branch office more than once.

SCHEDULE

This Constitutional Amendment takes effect upon being declared adopted in accordance with Section 7 of the Illinois Constitutional Amendment Act and applies to each person elected or appointed to an Executive Branch office or who serves as Acting Governor on and after the 2018 general election.
