10. Senator Shapiro.

11. SENATOR SHAPIRO:

12. Mr. President I move that the reading and approval  
13. of the Journals for Tuesday, November 13th, Wednesday,  
14. November 14th and Thursday, November 15th be postponed  
15. until the arrival of the printed copy.

16. PRESIDENT:

17. Senator Shapiro moves that the Journals of November  
18. 13th, 14th and 15th be postponed until the arrival of

20. by saying aye. Contrary no. The motion carries. Resolutions.  
21. Senator Bartulis I think has a Resolution, it is on the  
22. Secretary's desk. Yes. Senator Bartulis.

23. SENATOR BARTULIS:

24. Yes thank you Mr. President. Senate Resolution 288  
25. really has something to do with our now existing energy  
26. crisis. And what this Resolution does is establishes a  
27. sub-committee on energy to study the economic and human  
28. impact of the...present crisis to the citizens of Illinois.

30. Senator Bartulis moves to take from the Secretary's  
31. desk. All in favor signify by saying aye. Contrary no.  
32. The motion carries. Senator Bartulis moves the adoption  
33. of the Resolution. All in favor signify by saying aye.  
Contrary no. The motion carries, the Resolution is adopted.

9. SENATOR REGNER:

10. Mr. President I move for the suspension of the  
11. rules for the immediate consideration of Senate Joint  
12. Resolution 53.

13. PRESIDENT:

14. All in favor of the motion to suspend the rules  
15. for the immediate consideration of the Resolution, signify  
16. by saying aye. Contrary no. The motion carries.

17. SENATOR REGNER:

18. I now move for the adoption...passage of Senate  
19. Joint Resolution 53.

20. PRESIDENT:

21. Senator Regner moves the adoption of Senate Joint  
22. Resolution 53. All in favor signify by saying aye.  
23. Contrary no. The motion carries, the Resolution is  
24. adopted.

25. SECRETARY:

26. Senate Resolution 298 by Senators Harris, Graham,  
27. Mohr and Weaver.

28. (Secretary reads Resolution)

29. PRESIDENT:

30. Senator Mohr.

31. SENATOR HOWARD MOHR:

32. Mr. President, I move the suspension of the rules  
33. and the immediate adoption of the Resolution just read

1. by the Secretary.

2. PRESIDENT:

3. Senator Mohr moves the suspension for the suspension  
4. of the rules for the immediate consideration of the  
5. Resolution. All in favor signify by saying aye. Contrary  
6. no. The motion carries. On the motion to adopt, all in  
7. favor signify by saying aye. Contrary no. The motion  
8. carries, the Resolution is adopted.

24. Yes Mr. President, I would like leave of the Body  
25. to have all members shown on this Resolution.

26. PRESIDENT:

27. Is there leave? Leave is granted, so ordered.

28. SENATOR HOWARD MOHR:

29. The members will note that the Resolution was  
30. carefully drafted...didn't say anything about his new  
31. pants. I don't know whether we should have said some-  
32. thing about that or not.

33. PRESIDENT:

1. Well, it's...it's most appropriate that you have  
2. called our attention to them because if you hadn't we  
3. wouldn't of noticed them.

4. SENATOR HOWARD MOHR:

5. But...I, Mr. President I move for the suspension  
6. of the rules and the immediate adoption of this Resolution.

8. Is there objection? An objection has been made...  
9. Senator Knuepfer, you...you are recognized.

25. Senator Mohr moves to suspend the rules. All in  
26. favor signify by saying aye. Contrary no. The motion  
27. carries. On the motion to adopt, all in favor signify  
28. by saying aye. Contrary no. The motion carries. Resolution  
29. is adopted. Senator Ozinga.

30. SENATOR OZINGA:

31. I...I would like to have a point of inquiry of  
32. Senator Knuepfer. I noticed when Senator Mohr called  
33. the attention to the trousers, I wondered if he was one

15. carries, the Senate stands in recess subject to the call of

22. Senate Resolution 300 by Senator Davidson and it's

25. Senator Davidson.

26. SENATOR DAVIDSON:

27. Mr. President, Members of the Senate, this con-  
28. gratulatory Resolution, quick short word is - congratulate  
29. Earl Hensen who is the...the little man of the two man  
30. part on the outside of the doorkeeper who is 77 years old  
31. today and ask suspension of the rules to take up the  
32. Resolution, immediate adoption and ask all Senators to  
33. join me in the adoption of the Resolution.

1. PRESIDING OFFICER (SENATOR MOHR):

2. Senator Davidson asks that all Senators...asks leave  
3. that all Senators shall be shown as sponsors. Is there  
4. leave? All Senators shall be shown. Now Senator Davidson  
5. moves the suspension of the rules for consideration and  
6. immediate adoption of the Resolution. All those in favor

16. SENATOR KOSINSKI:

17. Mr. President, Senators, the Resolution congratulates  
18. the class of 1973 of the Illinois State Police cadets and  
19. commends them both on their graduation from the State  
20. Police Academy and their entrance into the ranks of the  
21. greatest State law enforcement organization in the United  
22. States, the Illinois State Police.
