PRESIDENT ROCK:

The hour of noon having arrived, the Senate will please come to order. Will the Members be at their desks, and will our guests in the gallery please rise. Our prayer this afternoon by Rabbi Barry A. Marks, Temple Israel, Springfield, Illinois. Rabbi.

RABBI BARRY A. MARKS:

(Remarks by Rabbi Barry A. Marks)

PRESIDENT ROCK:

Thank you, Rabbi. Reading of the Journal, Madam Secretary.

SECRETARY HAWKER:

PRESIDENT ROCK:

Senator Welch.

SENATOR WELCH:

Mr. President, I move that the Journals just read by the Secretary be approved, unless some Senator has additions or corrections to offer.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

You've heard the motion as placed by Senator Welch. Is there any discussion? If not, all in favor, indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The motion carries, and it's so ordered. Senator Welch.

SENATOR WELCH:

Mr. President, I move that reading and approval of the Journal of Friday, June 8th, in the year 1990, be postponed, pending arrival of the printed Journal.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

PRESIDENT ROCK:

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Consent Calendar. Senator Schuneman, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR SCHUNEMAN:

Thank you -- thank you, Mr. President. I would move to waive the appropriate rule to allow for the immediate consideration of Senate Resolution 1205.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

All right. Senator Schuneman has moved to suspend the rules for the immediate consideration and adoption of Senate Resolution 1205 - a congratulatory resolution that is to be presented this evening. All in favor of the Motion to Suspend, indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The rules are suspended. Senator Schuneman now moves the adoption of Senate Resolution 1205. Discussion? If not, all in favor, indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The resolution is adopted. Further resolutions?

SECRETARY HAWKER:

PRESIDENT ROCK:

Consent Calendar. Senator Demuzio, for what purpose do you arise, sir?

SENATOR DEMUZIO:

Thank you, Mr. President. I'd like the record to reflect that Senator Jerome Joyce is absent today due to illness.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

The record will so reflect. Senator Philip, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR PHILIP:

Thank you, Mr. President, Ladies and Gentlemen of the Senate. I'd like the record to indicate that Senator MacDonald is not here - may not be here all this week. Her husband has a serious

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illness, and she's by his bedside. Secondly, Senator Mahar's mother has passed away, and he is at the funeral.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

All right. The record will so reflect. Senator Dunn, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR R. DUNN:

Thank you, Mr. President. I -- I'd like to move to suspend the appropriate rule for the immediate consideration of Senate Resolution 1207. It is congratulatory.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

All right. Senator Dunn has moved to suspend the rules for the immediate consideration and adoption of Senate Resolution 1207 - a congratulatory resolution that's -- to be presented tomorrow, I'm told. All in favor of the Motion to Suspend, indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The rules are suspended. Senator Dunn now moves the adoption of Senate Resolution 1207. Discussion? If not, all in favor, indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The resolution is adopted. Senator Hall, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR HALL:

Thank you, Mr. President and Ladies and Gentlemen of the Senate. I'd like to ask leave to get a Senate Joint Resolution read, and the rules be suspended so that we can hear this. This is for Appellate Judge John Karns.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

All right. Senator Hall has the same request. He is moving to suspend the rules for the immediate consideration and adoption of Senate Joint Resolution 195. This is a joint resolution and is to be presented on Friday night of this week. All in favor of the Motion to Suspend, indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The rules are suspended. SECRETARY HAWKER:

A Message from the Governor by Stephen F. Selcke, Director of Legislative Affairs.

Mr. President - The Governor directs me to lay before the Senate the following message:

To the Honorable Members of the Senate, Eighty-sixth General Assembly: I have nominated and appointed the following named persons to the offices enumerated below and respectfully ask concurrence in and confirmation of these appointments of your Honorable Body.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

All right. Committee on Executive Appointments. All right. Ladies and Gentlemen, we're going to begin on Page 7 on the Calendar on the Order of House Bills 2nd Reading. The Chair has been informed that there are a number of these bills that either do not have an amendment or are of no controversy, and I would suggest we do not deal with controversial matters. Each side has a couple of Members missing for personal and official reasons. So we'll go through and -- and work for approximately an hour or an hour and a half and see how far we can get. 309. Senator Weaver. 318. Senator Etheredge. Read the bill, Madam Secretary, please. On the Order of House Bills 2nd Reading, top of Page 7, is House Bill 318. Read the bill, please.

SECRETARY HAWKER:

House Bill 318.

(Secretary reads title of bill)

2nd Reading of the bill. The Committee on Elementary and Secondary Education offers Committee Amendment No. 1.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

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Senator Etheredge, on Committee Amendment No. 1.

SENATOR ETHEREDGE:

Yes. Thank you, Mr. President, Ladies and Gentlemen of the Senate. This amendment adds two more employee classifications to those for whom the regional superintendent may -- may initiate criminal background checks, those two being the educational support personnel and contractual employees who are assigned to work in more than one district. I would move for the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

All right. Senator Etheredge has moved the adoption of Committee Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 318. Discussion? If not, all in favor, indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The amendment's adopted. Further amendments?

Mr. President, Ladies and Gentlemen of the Senate, on May 17th and 18th, in the University of Illinois in Champaign, nineteen --

PRESIDENT ROCK:

May I ask the staff to take the conferences off the Floor,

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please? Senator Dudycz, I'm sorry.

SENATOR DUDYCYZ:

-- nineteen Resurrection High School students participated in the statewide science competition at the Junior Academy of Science Fair. In the second year in a row, the Resurrection High School won first place in the State. In the gallery on the Democratic side, the nineteen students, as well as their teachers, are with us. And I would ask leave to read Senate Resolution 1-1-9-6.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

All right. The Gentleman seeks leave to read the Senate resolution. Leave is granted. Senator Dudycz.

SENATOR DUDYCYZ:

(Senator Dudycz reads SR No. 1196)

Thank you, Mr. President. And could --

Senator Dudycz.

SENATOR DUDYCYZ:

I'd like for our guests to please rise and be recognized.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

Will our guests please rise and be -- welcome to Springfield. All right. On the Order of House Bills 2nd Reading, House Bill 950. Senator Kelly. 951. Senator Kelly. 982. Senator Schuneman. 1055. Senator MacDonald. Senator Philip. Senator Philip. Wait a minute. Are we going to move Ginny's bills?

SENATOR PHILIP:

Yes.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

Okay.

SENATOR PHILIP:

Please, Mr. President. I think there's a Committee Amendment No. 1.

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All right. Read the bill, Madam Secretary, please.

SECRETARY HAWKER:

House Bill 1055.

(Secretary reads title of bill)

PRESIDENT ROCK:

It had come out of the Senate and -- as an agreed bill list. And it discusses community college -- it clarifies how

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insurance is used for board members - which is not at all. And the second part is how you use credit cards. And as I said, it was totally noncontroversial.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

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in the Department of Transportation spending from the Road Fund. If we do not voluntarily pay it back next year, then the third year, one twelfth a month will be automatically transferred by the Comptroller from General Revenue to the Road Fund - and Senator Netsch guarantees that she will so do -- that the -- at the end of that fiscal year all funds will, in fact, be paid back to the Road Fund. There is no cash impact on the Road Fund at all. We have seen the cash flow projections as defined in the five-year plan and the budget book. At no time would their balance during the year we use it, or the two years we pay it back - the combined balance will never go below three hundred million in the bank. It'll be paid back long before there would have been a usage of these funds. This would guarantee the payback, and I would move adoption of Amendment No. 2.
