That led to the Zyklon-B gas chambers and to what Hitler called the "Final Solution." So fifty years ago we saw what happened when people did not know - did not remember - did not understand. And Illinois has taken the lead in teaching the future generations, so that for all times in the future we can say, "Never again." And I thank you, Mr. President, for the participation of the General Assembly in the procedures, and to -- to the people of Illinois for also participating. Thank you.
