PRESIDENT ROCK:

If not, Senator Sam moves that the Senate, in its First Special Session of the Eighty-seventh General Assembly, stand adjourned until Thursday, April 25th -- we're not ready for that yet -- Thursday, April 25th, at the hour of one o'clock. Senate stands adjourned. All right. Republican Caucus immediately in Senator Philip's office. Democrats immediately, please, to 212. The committees will commence at three o'clock. Senate stands adjourned.
