SENATOR HALL:

Thank you, Mr. President and Ladies and Gentlemen of the Senate. I move that the Journals just read by the Secretary be approved, unless some Senator or -- has additions or corrections to offer.

SENATOR DEMUZIO:

Thank you, Mr. President. House Joint Resolution 2 in the First Special Session calls for us -- it's the adjournment resolution -- calls for us to come back next Tuesday at the hour of twelve-thirty. So I would move to suspend and adopt.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

Gentleman has moved to suspend the rules for the immediate consideration and adoption of House Joint Resolution 2 in the First Special Session. Discussion? If not, all in favor of the Motion to Suspend, indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The rules are suspended. Senator Demuzio now moves the adoption of House Joint Resolution No. 2. Discussion? If not, all in favor, indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The resolution is adopted. Further business to come before the Senate? Further announcements? Senator Vadalabene.

SENATOR VADALABENE:

Yes. Just another final announcement. Aurora - 7; Edwardsville - 16, final.

PRESIDENT ROCK:

Sixty-four in a row. We're delighted. Further business to come before the Senate? If not, Senator Demuzio moves that the Senate, in its First Special Session, stand adjourned until next Tuesday, June 11, at the hour of twelve-thirty. Senate stands adjourned.
