All in favor of the Motion to Suspend, indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The rules are suspended. Senator Demuzio now moves the adoption of House Joint Resolution No. 3. Discussion? If not, all in favor, indicate by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. And the resolution is adopted.
