## SECRETARY HAWKER:

The Senate is now in Perfunctory Session.

A Message from the House by Mr. Mahoney, Clerk.

Mr. President - I am directed to inform the Senate that the House of Representatives has concurred with the Senate in the passage of a bill of the following title, to wit:

Senate Bill 1827, together with House Amendments 1 and 2.

Passed the House, as amended, April 18, 2006.

I have like Messages on Senate Bill 2487 with House Amendment 1, Senate Bill 2673 with House Amendment 1, and Senate Bill 2772 with House Amendment 1, which passed the House, as amended, April 18, 2006.

I have a like Message -- with respect to all of these Messages, passed the House, as amended, April 19th.

A like Message with respect to Senate Bill 2199 with House Amendment 2, and -- 2726 with House Amendment 1, and Senate Bill 3086 with House Amendments 1, 2 and 3.

Each of those three bills passed the House, as amended, April 19, 2006.

I have a Message -- pardon me, an Executive Order, dated -- received -- pardon me, March 31, 2006.
